

- 1. Great diversity of coastal and seabed habitats.
- 2. Seventeen EU Annex 1 habitats.
- 3. Two EU priority habitats.
- 4. 29% of Ireland's coastal lagoon habitat.
- 5. Biggest, best, and the bestdocumented lagoon in Ireland.
- 6. Highest number of lagoonal specialists in the country.
- 7. Twelve *Flora (Protection) Order* species of wild plants.
- 8. Three species of plant found nowhere else in Ireland.
- 9. One of the highest densities of fish species in Ireland.
- 10. Biggest spawning and nursery area for Herring on the south coast of Ireland.
- 11. Important spawning grounds Haddock, Whiting, and Cod.
- 12. Major seabird migration route.
- 13. Important seabird nesting and foraging area.
- 14. Best-documented bird site in Ireland.
- 15. Internationally important for a nesting colony of the rarest breeding seabird in Europe.
- 16. Top site in Ireland for breeding Mediterranean Gulls.
- 17. Forty-two species of wild birds that are EU Species of Conservation Interest (SCIs).
- Hot spot for Bottlenose Dolphins, Harbour Porpoises, Fin Whales, and Risso's Dolphins.
- 19. Largest Grey Seal colony in south-east Ireland.
